

THE BEST FIFA FOOTBALL AWARDS 2016

RULES OF ALLOCATION

The articles below relate to the following award:

- **FIFA FIFPro World11**

- Art. 1. The FIFA FIFPro World11 awards are organised by FIFPro.
- Art. 2. The awards are for the best players in each position based on their performances during the period from 1 December 2015 to 28 November 2016 inclusive.
- Art. 3. Players must have appeared in at least 15 official matches (at national or international level) during the period from 1 December 2015 to 28 November 2016 to be eligible.
- Art. 4. The winners of the awards are selected by professional players from around the world.
- Art. 5. Each vote carries the same weight.
- Art. 6. Players may vote for any current professional player, including themselves and team-mates from the same club or national team.
- Art. 7. Each voting player nominates one (1) goalkeeper, four (4) defenders, three (3) midfielders and three (3) forwards.
- Art. 8. The player with the most votes in each position will be named in the FIFA FIFPro World11.
- Art. 9. Where a player receives a vote in more than one position (for example, as a striker and as a midfielder), the votes will be combined and FIFPro will determine the position in which the player's votes will be counted.
- Art. 10. In the event of a tie for the last available place in a position (when the number of players exceeds the permitted number of positions), the player who has played the most international matches for his country shall be selected.
- Art. 11. FIFPro's decision will be final and binding.
